Prophecy

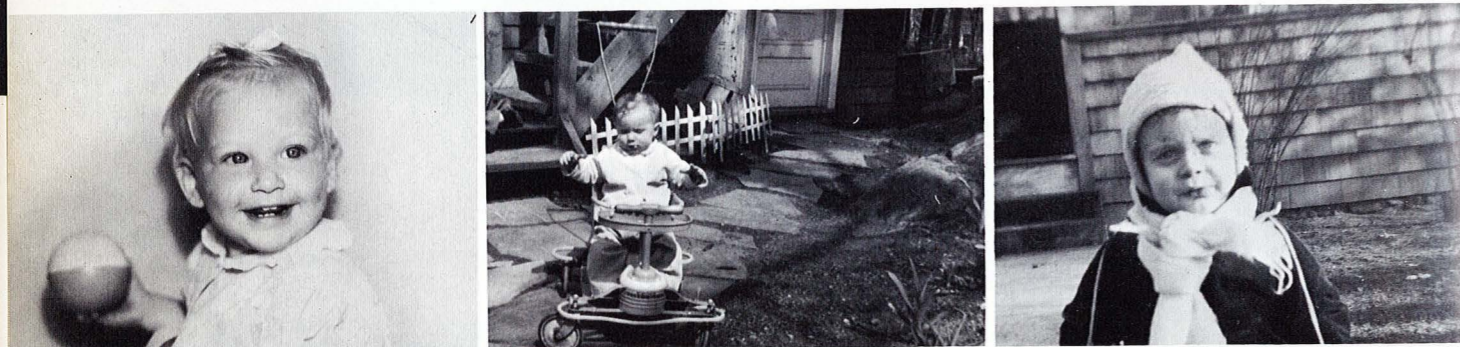
What does the future hold for the class of '66? An enlightening glance into the nearest crystal ball reveals some interesting post-high school developments.....
