Ohhh! Yearbook subscriptions, Graduation Announcements, caps and gowns!

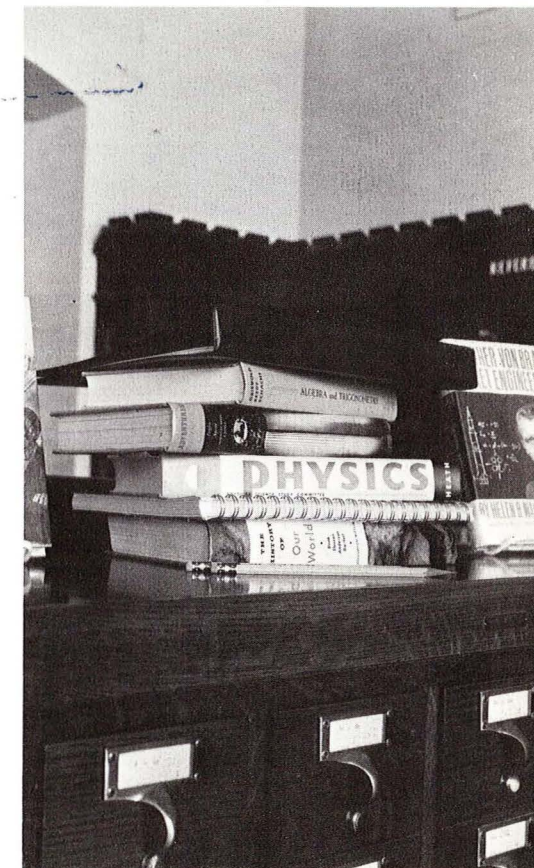
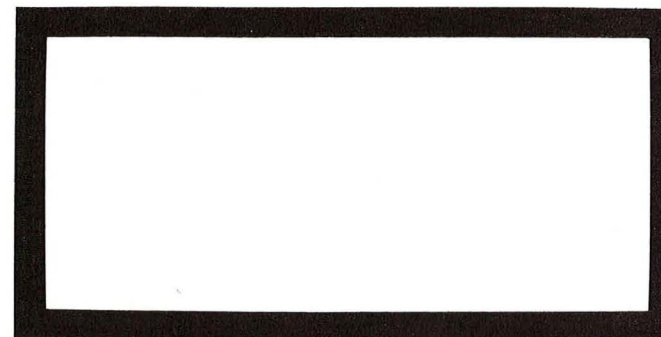
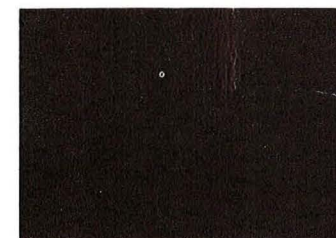
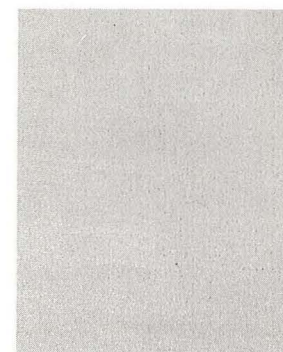
Well, we met the final yearbook deadline . . . now, full speed ahead on our senior play . . . Ah, Easter Vacation . . . ten days of rest?!
