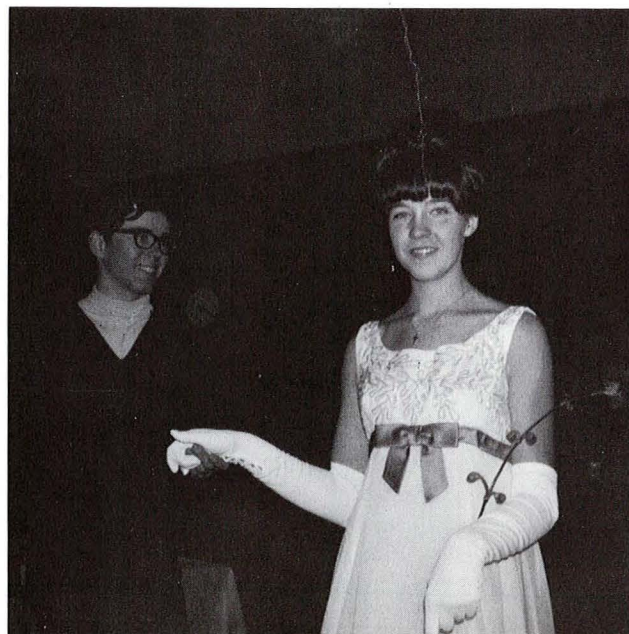
GIRLS STATE AND BOYS STATE
