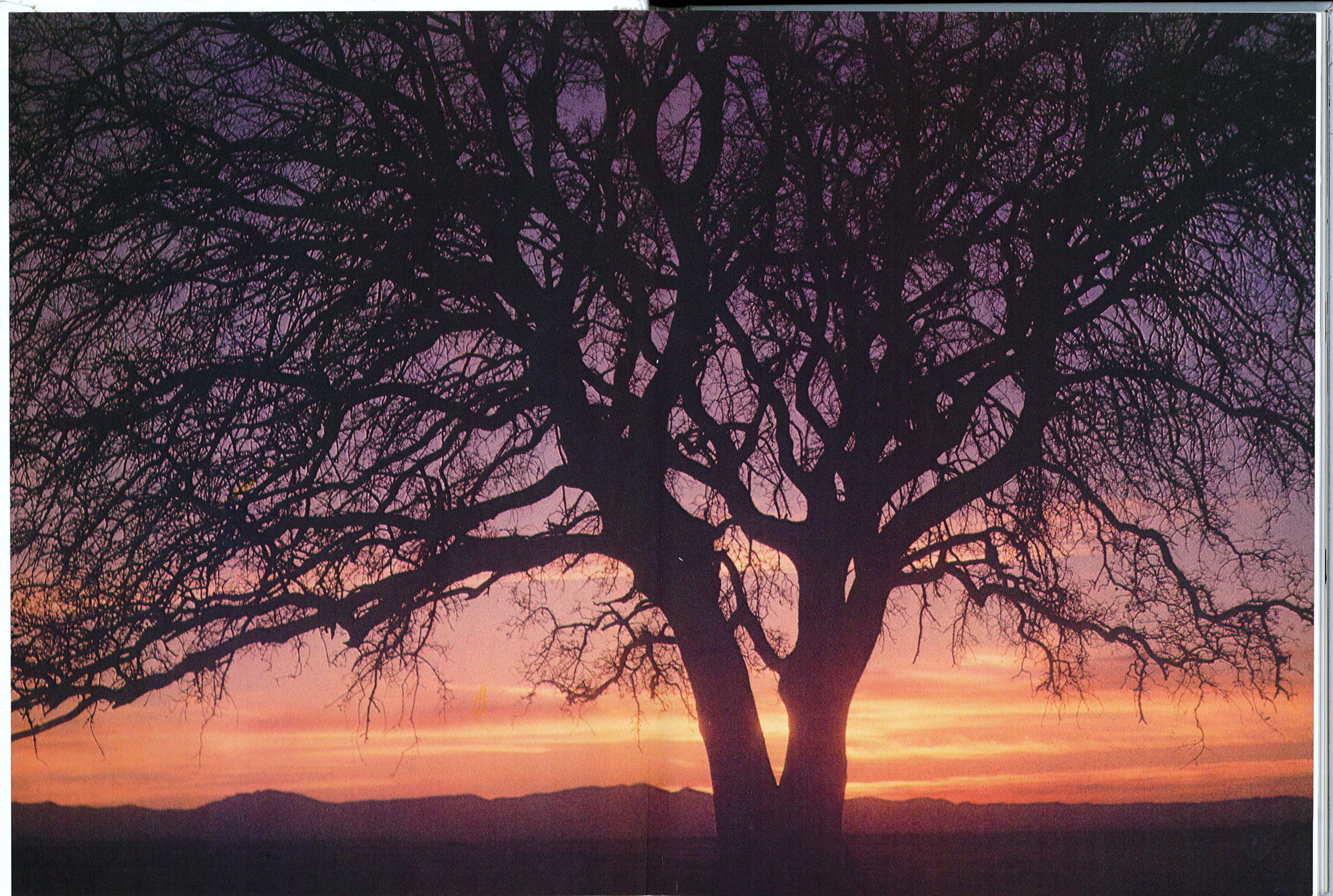

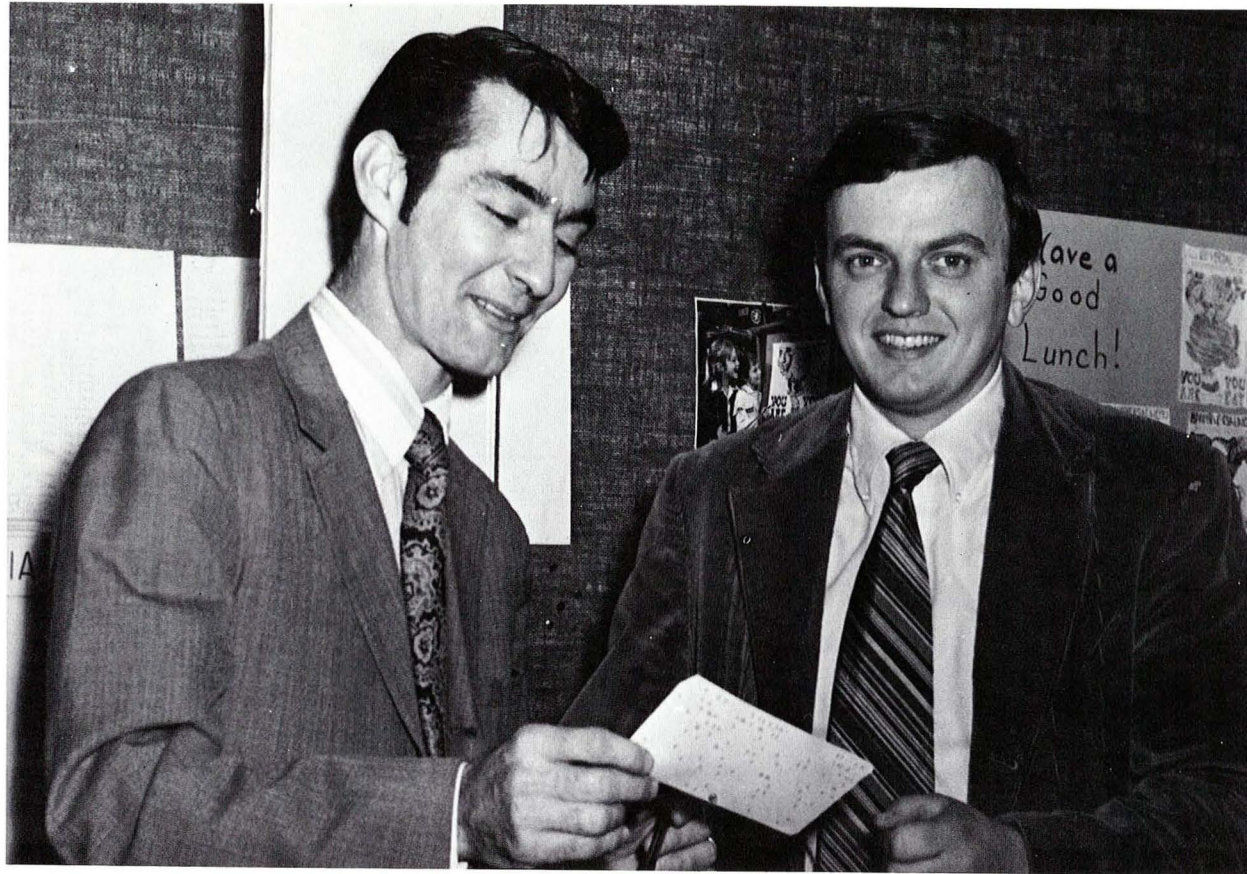

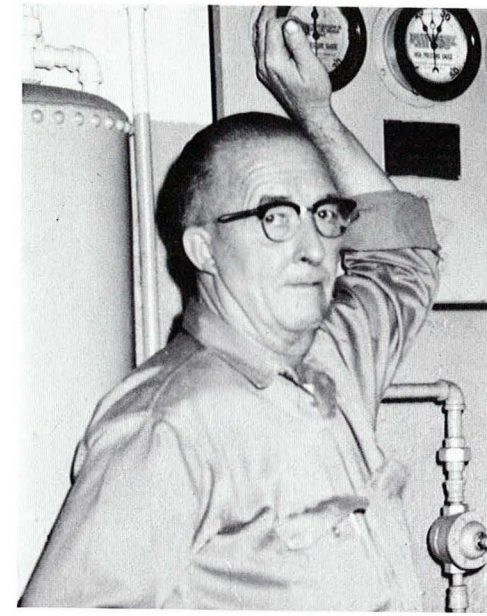


# DEDICATION
