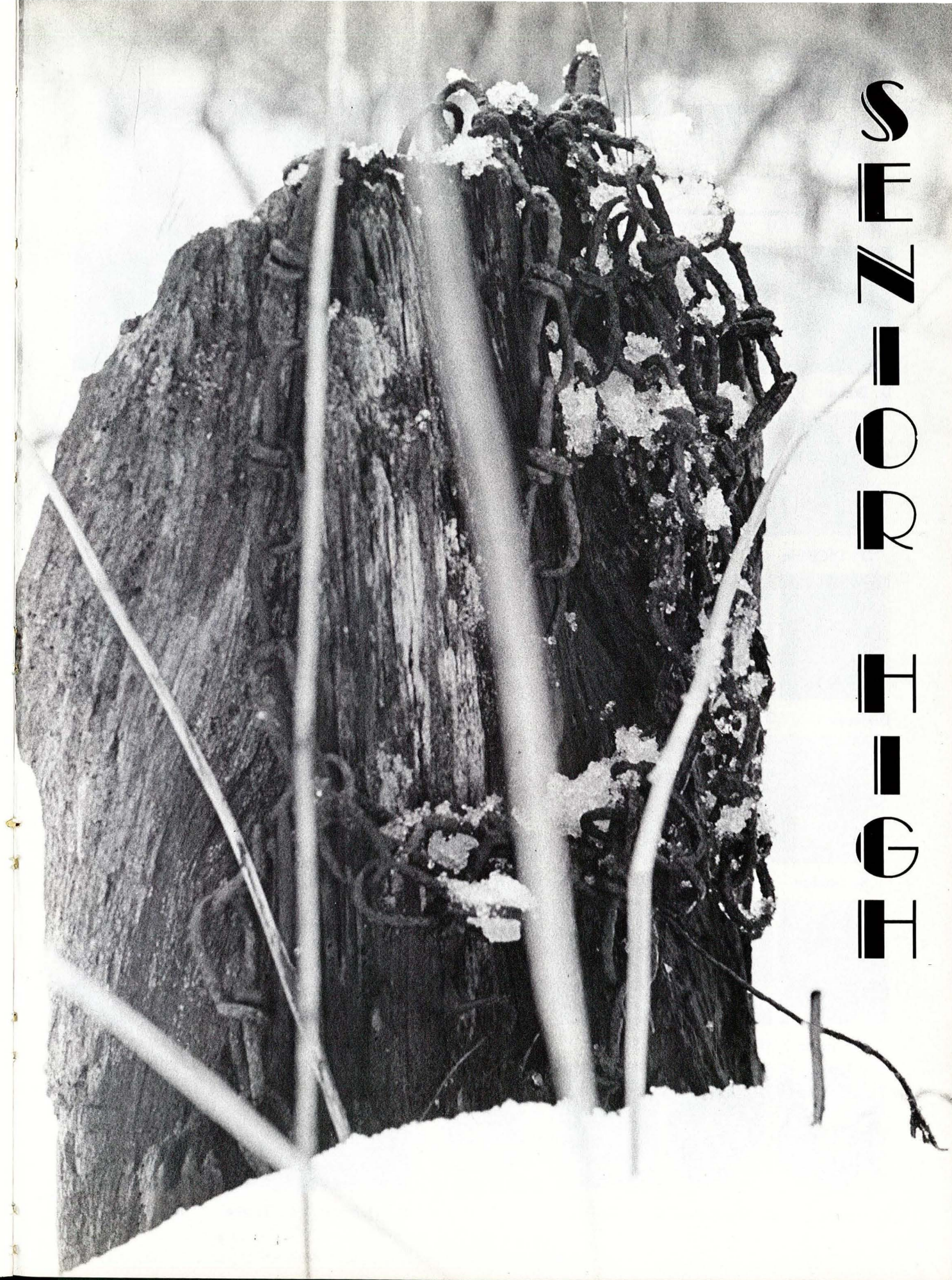
As the party slowly comes to a close, most of the guests have either passed out or are on their way to the board meeting. We wish them luck in whatever they do.
