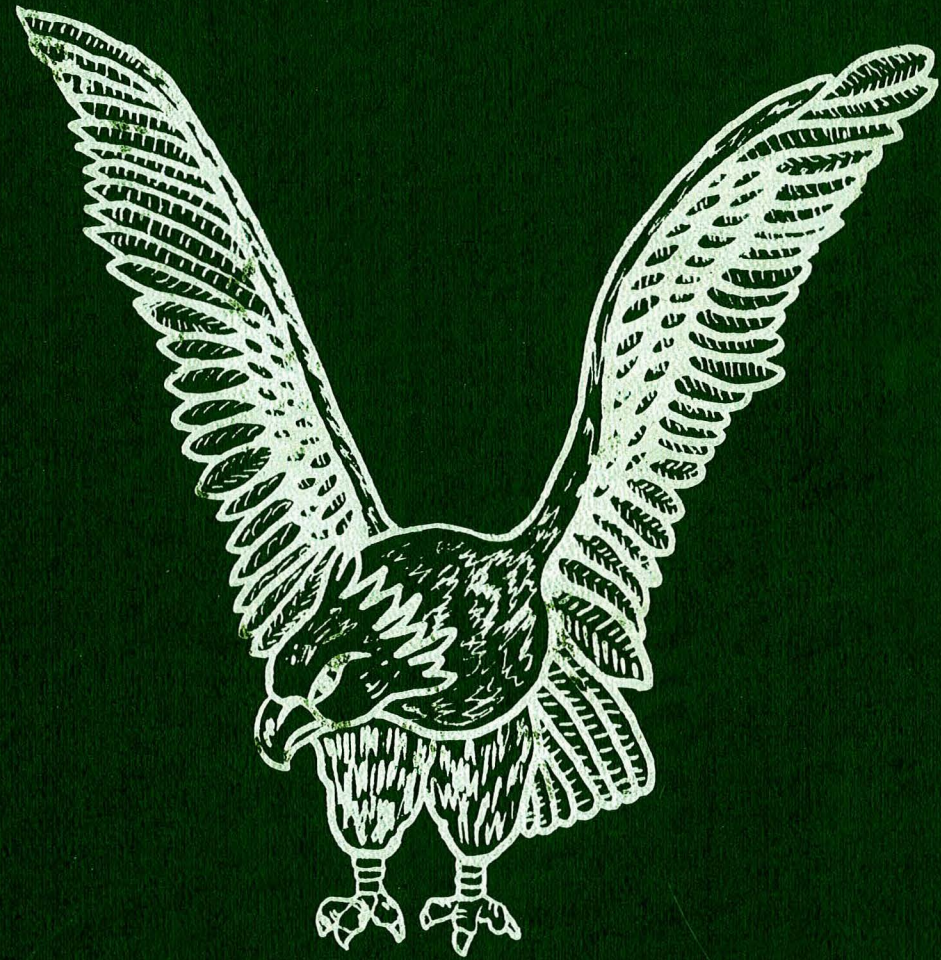

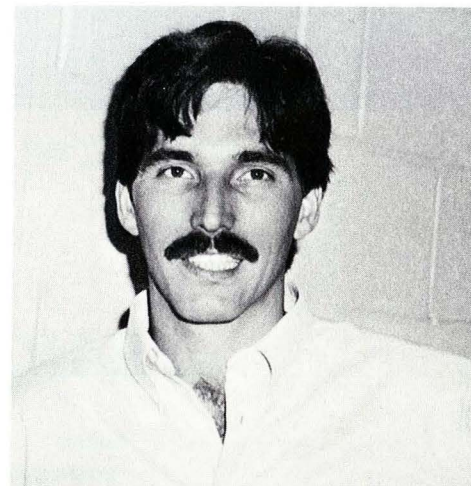
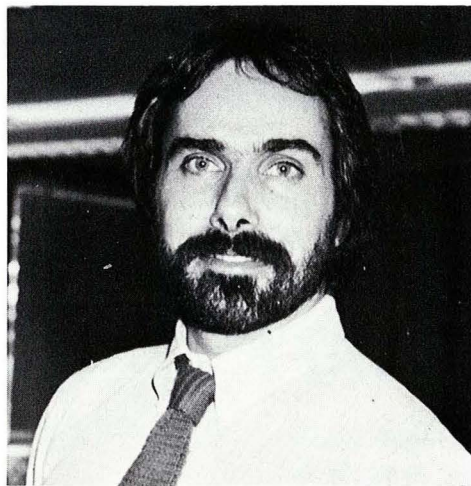

Of us

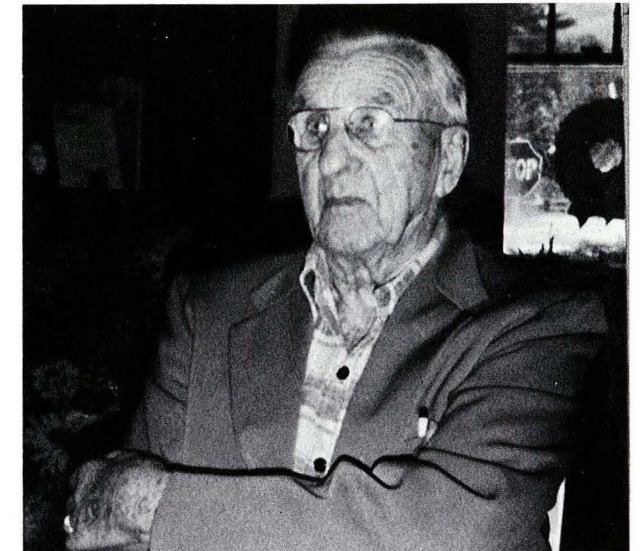
