DEDICATION



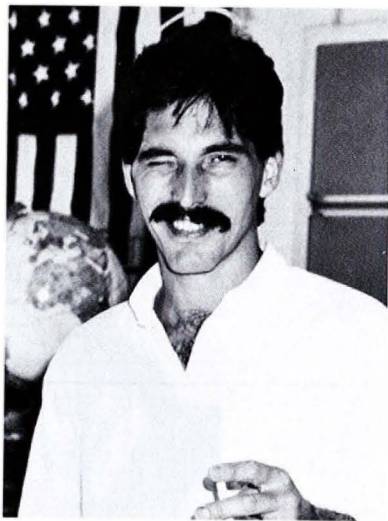
