
1995 UNDEFEATED MYAC


ur BCS Bolton Varsity Baseball Team garnered the 1995 Mountain and Valley Conference Championship while recording an undefeated 12-0 league record. On the way to this honor they recorded 15 consecutive victories and finished with an impressive 15-1 mark, losing only to defending state champion Lake Placid in the sectional finals. This marks the 7th consecutive league title for the Eagles and extends Coach Donahue's league winning streak to over 50 games — a streak that began back during the beginning of the 1989 season. Entering the season as underdogs, these "Diamond" Dogs lived up to past expectations and experienced one of the most successful seasons in recent Bolton baseball history. This year's proponents of "Bolton Ball" outscored their opponents by a 195-40 run margin.


Selected for 1st Team MVAC All-Stars were conference MVP Justin Mowery, Seth Fagnano, Brian Perry, and Luke Schweickert, while Jesse Foy and Sam Bennett were chosen 2nd team and Lance Truax and Greg Perry earned Honorable Mention. Coach Donahue was named by league officials as Coach of the Year for the MVAC. Instrumental in this achievement were the contributions of Adam Railing, Chris Urtz, Jon Dumas, Dan Perry, and Kyle Ramos.



Coach Donahue and Justin Mowery strike a championship pose after being named MVAC "Coach of the Year" and "MVP" respectively.







were Jesse and Christine.


